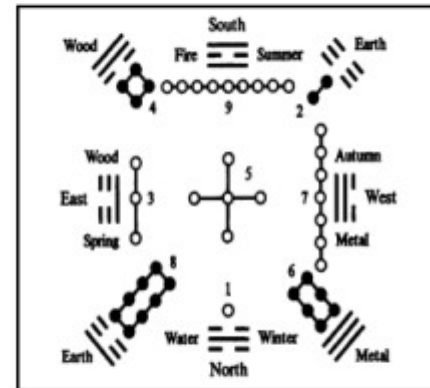
## The Magic Square

$$1+2+3+4+5 = 15$$

$$6+9 = 15$$

$$7+8 = 15$$

$$(15 \times 3) + 5 = 50$$



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$$1+2+3+4+5+6+7+8+9+10 = 55$$

The reason why the number five occurs two times is as follow:

- 1 + 9 = 10
- 2 + 8 = 10
- 3 + 7 = 10
- 4 + 6 = 10
- 5 + ? = 10

As ten is the highest number and it's ingredients as a whole must contain it, giving the "Great Expansion" ie **fifty** [The great treatise, 5' Wing] the number five has to occur two times: 5 + 5 = 10, as well.
